

# R E S T R I C T E D

1. The 70th Infantry Division was activated by General Order Number 1, 15 June 1943 at Camp Adair, Oregon, pursuant to General Order Number 38, Headquarters IV Corps, Fort Lewis, Washington, dated 24 May 1943.
