Born in 1926 Private Bannon entered the service on May-19, 1944 in New Cumberland, PA

At the time of enlistment Private Bannon was single and employed as a welder

Pvt. Bannon was wounded during the battle of Rothbach Creek, France around 11:00 am Jan-7-1945
He was hit by small arms fire while manning the machine gun. He died of his wounds later that day.

Two other members of his platoon were killed in this incident.

1 st Lt. John D Duffy and Sgt. T. Marvin Schnell

S/Sgt. Damon B. Taylor was also wounded.
