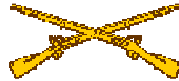

Purple Heart

1st LT. Duffy was killed in action during the battle of Rothbach Creek, France around 11:00 am Jan-7-1945  
He was hit by small arms fire while manning a machine gun.  
Two other members of his platoon were killed in this incident.  
Sgt. T. Marvin Schnell and Pvt. Harry S Bannon  
S. Sgt. Damon B. Taylor was wounded.  
1st Lt. John D Duffy is buried in Epinal American Cemetery, France, Plot A Row 8 Grave 27  
next to his brother Pvt. Edward F Duffy 45th ID 180th Infantry KIA Sep-12-1944 Plot A Row 8 Grave 28  
Ironically the operation in which Lt. Duffy was killed was in support of the 45th Division
