Bronze Star Medal

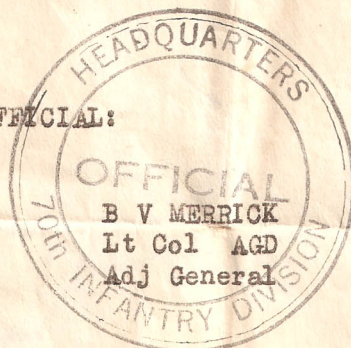
By direction of the President, under the provisions of AR 600-45, 22 Sep 43, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded to the following individual for meritorious service in connection with military operations against the enemy from 26 December 1944 to 15 April 1945, in Alsace, France, and Germany.

GEORGE L LYNN, 37 537 580, Staff Sergeant, Service Company, 275th Infantry. Throughout this period of contact with the enemy and the reorganization of his battalion in Germany, Staff Sergeant Lynn, Battalion Supply Sergeant, performed his duties in a superior manner. During the attack on Brandenbusch Woods and Spicheren Heights, France, he was repeatedly exposed to enemy artillery and rifle fire, delivering food, ammunition and clothing to the front lines. In this action he assisted in organizing and leading a pack train over wooded hills to the companies, thereby enabling the battalion to advance and consolidate its positions. His leadership and perseverance in making supplies available contributed to the battalion's success.
